Amy Riley, update on student financial readiness

• OSU is changing requirements and deadlines for paying tuition bills this fall term. Currently the threshold to hold a balance is \$2200 but this is lowering to \$500. If they

- are not on a payment plan or their balance is lower than \$500, they will not be able to enroll in the following term.
- They will also have access to peer financial counseling, and they will be able to see their bill amounts earlier than in the past, now in august.
- This is the same for all students, graduate and undergrad, online and in person.
- Amy is currently trying to gather data on how many of our students this will affect.
